What is Words in the Park?

- An annual event celebrating local authors and their works hosted by the Strathcona County Library and the Writers Foundation of Strathcona County
- An opportunity for local authors and anyone who creates with words to sell and promote their work
- An opportunity to network with other authors and the public

When and Where?

- Saturday, November 19, 1- 4 pm in the Strathcona County Library
- Community Centre, Centre in the Park, 401 Festival Lane, Sherwood Park

Who can apply?

- Anyone who writes or creates with words, and who has a connection to Strathcona County

When is the submission deadline?

- Accepting applications now
- Deadline is Thursday, September 15, 2011

How much does it cost to participate?

- There is a \$15.00 non-refundable table fee

What is the applicant's responsibility when renting a table?

- Arrive and set up at your designated table prior to 1 pm
- Bring and unload your own merchandise
- Sell merchandise
- Be present from 1-4 pm

How much table space is available?

- Two participants will share a table with each having a 2^{1/2} feet by 2^{1/2} feet for display.

Is there parking available?

- Underground parking is available for a cost of \$2/day
- Free parking is available on the surface across from the library's main entrance.

Where can attendees get food or drinks?

- Free light refreshments will be available on site

How can the public pay for merchandise?

- Each applicant must be able to accept cash or cheques.
- The Library cannot provide Interac at this time
